

## Requesting an Extension of Currently Approved Fuel Cost Policy

On June 15, 2018, the Fuel Cost Policy annual review process will begin. By the end of the day, Friday, June 15, Market Sellers are required to either:

- a. Submit an updated Fuel Cost Policy applicable for the November 1, 2018 through October 31, 2019 period (2018/2019); or
- b. Confirm to PJM and to the MMU that their current approved Fuel Cost Policy remains compliant, and that the Market Seller intends to continue to use the current approved Fuel Cost Policy for the November 1, 2018 through October 31, 2019 period.

Market Sellers who intend to submit a new Fuel Cost Policy should log into the Member Information Reporting Application (MIRA) system and submit their Fuel Cost Policy as described in the “Guide to Submitting Fuel Policies” in:

The MMU highly recommends labeling Fuel Cost Policies intended for the 2018/2019 period with the suffix “2018/2019.” This will allow for a better distinction of Fuel Cost Policies submitted during the 2018 Fuel Cost Policy Annual Review versus Fuel Cost Policies submitted outside of the 2017 Fuel Cost Policy Annual Review.

Market Sellers who intend to confirm that their current approved Fuel Cost Policy remains compliant and that they intend to continue to use the current approved Fuel Cost Policy, should click the checkbox “Approved FCP Compliance Extension” in the Edit Fuel Policies screen in MIRA. The “Approved FCP Compliance Extension” checkbox is now available in MIRA. This is a temporary solution while the MMU works on the development of a redesigned Fuel Cost Policy module.

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Market Sellers should check this box only for Fuel Cost Policies with a PJM Status of “Approved” that the Market Seller intends to continue to use as the applicable Fuel Cost Policy through November 1, 2019. The check box will not be locked by June 15, PJM and the MMU will have the record of the Market Sellers’ selection by June 15. Selection changes made after June 15 will not be valid.

The current approved Fuel Cost Policies expire on November 1, 2018. Market Sellers that do not confirm the extension of the current approved Fuel Cost Policies and fail to submit new Fuel Cost Policies by June 15, 2018 may be subject to penalties per Schedule 2 of the PJM Operating Agreement if they do not have an approved Fuel Cost Policy by November 1, 2018.
