Current Regulation Cost Allocation

- Current costs are limited to \$/MW per hour of regulation
- Current costs are defined in M15 as \$/MWh in terms of:
 - Fuel cost increase and heat rate degradation cost
 - Cost increase in VOM
 - Margin Risk Adder

Performance Based Regulation Cost Allocation

- Capability offers cost to reserve resource for regulation service, defined as \$/MW per hour cost
- Performance offers costs associated with a resource tracking regulation signal
 - Defined as \$/mile costs

Issue

- M15 defines only \$/MWh costs associated with regulation
 - Defined as capability costs
- New regulation rules account for possibility that the \$/mile charge could include performance costs that vary with actual regulation
- These costs, if any, should only include costs that vary on a per mile basis
- If any costs are offered on a per mile basis, change in M15 required to define them
- The new regulation rules provide for recovery of all defined costs of regulation

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
