

prior filings has shown the need to thoroughly investigate the facts represented. The Commission granted an additional two weeks in a similar proceeding concerning a petition filed by Old Dominion Electric Cooperative.⁵ As in that case, good cause exists to afford adequate time for an evaluation of material that took several months for the filing party to prepare.

An extension of the comment period by at least two weeks would yield a comment deadline of December 17, 2014. That additional time would allow the Market Monitor and other parties to submit more complete filings that will improve the record in this proceeding.

Accordingly, for good cause shown, the Market Monitor respectfully requests that the Commission grant this motion for extension.
