PJM IMM Statement

- PJM IMM does not agree that a clear issue related to congestion payments has been adequately demonstrated
- PJM IMM is committed to continuing analysis/model development and discussions with PJM, MISO and MISO IMM to determine whether an issue exists

PJM IMM Statement

- PJM IMM does not agree that changing the LMP calculation to eliminate the congestion component for interface prices is appropriate
- PJM IMM believes that the PJM plan to use 10 buses close to the border with equal weightings for the PJM/MISO interface price is the logical next step



PJM IMM Statement

- PJM IMM believes that both PJM and MISO should use the same approach to defining the interface price
- PJM IMM believes that the appropriate long-term solution is to treat the interface as a constraint under a joint dispatch model that replicates the market clearing logic of a single LMP market
